## NOTICE OF SERIES

The following paragraphs are in addition to the Notice the Race and Sailing Instructions for the 2019 Wednesday Evening Series and should be read in conjunction with them.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The series is open to all classes eligible to sail at Queen Mary Sailing Club. All boats must be helmed by Club members, temporary Club members or full-time members of staff who are paid up members of the RYA.

### 7. SCHEDULE

The following race days constitute the series.

### 13. SCORING

- 13.1 Rule A9 "Race Scores in a Series Longer than a Regatta" will apply.
- 13.2 6 races are required to be completed to constitute the series.
- 13.3 (a) Discards: once 6 races have been complete, 1 discard will come into effect. After 9 races a boat's score will be the sum of her best 8 races.
- (b) The expected series will include 9 races for which 6 will count.
- 13.4 A maximum of 2 Race Officer duties will contribute to the series score.

### 19. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the three highest placed boats, with a cup being presented to the winner at the Club Supper on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019.
